



Rules and conditions of participation in the REGC tournament

Registrations :

- The Real Estate Golf Cup is a golf competition that takes place over 3 days and is made up of two qualifying days and a final. The competition is played by teams of 2 people. A team can register and participate both in the 2 qualifying days and in the final. Only the 4 best teams per category will be invited to the final.
- Registrations are made only online on the website www.regc.be or by email at the personal invitation of the organizer or one of its sponsors or partners.
- The REGC competition is open exclusively to people active in the real estate sector and to people invited by the organizers or partners.
- To participate, the player must be at least 21 years old on the day of the tournament.
- To participate, the player must be a member of a recognized club and have a maximum handicap of 36 and registered with the Royal Belgian Golf Federation or another recognized foreign federation. Without a valid license from a recognized federation, the player will not be able to participate in the competition or will be disqualified. Only the organizers can derogate from this rule on an exceptional basis.
- It is up to the player to prove his exact handicap (WHS) and to verify it on his scorecard.
- Cancellation: if a player cancels his participation less than 5 days before the date of the tournament, the participation fees will not be refunded to cover the costs already advanced.
- A team can only participate if all the players are in order of payment on the day of the event.

Golf : game formula and rules :

- For the qualifications, the game formula used is 4 Ball Aggregate Stableford over 18 holes. Participation is by team of two. The two stableford scores are added together. Both partners add their Stableford score at each hole (eg 3 points + 2 points = 5 points). The player's moves and scores (unless 0 is the score) must be recorded on the card. The scores are then added together with the highest number of winning points.
- The 4 best teams per category will be invited to participate in the final.
- A team can be mixed and composed of a maximum of one single HCP player.
- The same company can register as many teams as it wishes.
- The same team can register for all qualifications.



- A team qualified for the final will not have to pay its green fee / registration fee. A team not qualified for the final can participate in the final by paying its green fee / registration fee.
- Only teams qualified or registered for the final will be eligible for a prize.
- A player can register with a different partner on different qualifying days. However, the composition of the team having won an invitation to the final cannot be modified on the day of the final. Therefore, if two teams composed of the same player win an invitation to the final, one of these two teams cannot be qualified.
Ex: If team AB wins an invitation to the final in Q1 and team AC also wins an invitation in Q2. Player A will have to choose in which team he wishes to be invited to the final.
- Players are divided into 2 categories:
 - Category 1: WHS Hcp up to 18 (mixed)
 - Category 2: WHS Hcp between 18 and 36 (mixed)
- The competition is played “Front-tee”, so usually “yellow” for Men and “red” for Ladies
- Local rules apply in the host clubs of each leg
- Scorecards must be checked and signed by the player and scorer. Incomplete or incorrectly marked cards will result in player disqualification. Completed cards must be returned within 10 minutes of completing the course. Any delay in delivering the scorecard may result in disqualification.
- Guests of partners and sponsors can also win a prize and qualify for the final. This rule does not apply to the organizers if they are brought to play.
- If the winner of one of the prizes is not present at the award ceremony, his prize will not be awarded. The organizer reserves the right to remove the unawarded prize from the prize table or to assign it to the next player in the ranking.
- In the event of a tie, the tie will be decided successively on the basis of the best score over the last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes and last hole. If there is still a tie, the lowest WHS Hcp wins.

Prizes and invitation to the final:

The prize category is as follows:

- The best GROSS score in all categories
- the 2 best NET Cat scores. 1
- the 2 best NET Cat scores. 2
- the best men's individual score
- the best female individual score
- man's longest drive
- women's longest drive
- nearest to the pin



Are invited to the final:

- the 4 best NET Cat scores. 1
- the 4 best NET Cat scores. 2

In total, there will therefore be a maximum of **16 players** invited to the final.

In case of withdrawal from the Belgian final, the organizer reserves the right to reallocate the place to another player who participated in a qualifying round, regardless of his result in the classification.

Other dispositions:

- The organizers reserve the right to modify the rules of the competition at any time.
- Any breach of these rules may result in disqualification from the competition.
- Carts are not allowed for participants, except for a valid medical certificate which must be shown to the organization on the day of the competition. Cart rental will be the responsibility of the participant.
- In the event of cancellation, postponement, or interruption of the competition due to bad weather, storms, storms or other cases of force majeure, the organizer reserves the right to decide the outcome of the tournament and the results.
- By registering, participants agree to assign their image rights for the communication of the event and to appear on the social networks of the event.
- By registering, participants accept these rules and the conditions of participation.
- Calendar of the 2022 edition subject to the health situation. The organization reserves the right to modify the program at any time and will follow the protocols in force.
